Job Purpose	Achieve Success Coaches work with low-income, first-generation, or academically disadvantaged students to develop social, academic, and cultural competence to achieve their post-secondary goals. Success Coaches serve as the liaison between their high school and Achieve Miami to ensure implementation and successful progress towards program objectives.
Compensation	\$25-\$30 per hour 8 hours (maximum) per week

Duties and Responsibilities	 Achieve Scholars Provide progressive, one-on-one college and career advising to a cohort of 15 - 20 students during the academic year. Coordinate and conduct bi-weekly workshops, as provided from Achieve Miami, to provide guidance for high school and post-secondary success, such as: Career Planning College Selection ACT/SAT Tutoring Financial Aid/FAFSA Admissions/Scholarship Applications Facilitate annual recruitment at the high school with a focus on rising upperclassmen during the academic year for the Achieve Scholars Program Meet weekly with fellow Achieve Success Coaches and Achieve Miami's High School Staff to reflect on and plan for upcoming workshops, activities, etc.

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	 Assist with student and program data collection to ensure students are on track to graduate during the academic year. This includes tracking participants' academic progress (nine-week grades, semester grades, and standardized test scores). Counsel, monitor, and maintain records of student attendance and participation to provide ongoing effective feedback to students, including tracking their progress towards statutory requirements for the program. Chaperone small group visits to local and national college campuses, if applicable. Collaborate with the school administration, counselors, and CAP Advisors to enhance student success and experience. Optional: Provide fundamental support to the Achieve Saturday programming.
