

Reading & Behavior Interventionist

Caribbean K-8 Center, Achieve Summer 2026

Achieve Summer is a full-day, six-week program that engages elementary, middle and high school students in high-quality academic and enriching summer experiences, while developing the leadership of teachers across Miami-Dade. Achieve Miami is seeking a **Reading & Behavior Interventionist** to join the Achieve Summer team at Caribbean K-8 Center (Cutler Bay). This position will lead first through fifth grade reading intervention groups as well as support the school site with positive behavioral interventions.

The role is part-time, working Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm.

Responsibilities

- Administer pre and post-reading assessments for 1st-5th grade students to determine their reading proficiency levels.
- Use assessment results to form targeted small groups of up to five students for focused daily Differentiated Literacy Instruction (DLI), including phonics, fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary development.
- Develop and implement individualized reading intervention plans, informed by science-backed curriculum provided by The Children's Trust, to increase identified students' reading level within the 6 week program.
- Monitor student progress and adjust interventions as necessary using data-driven decisions.
- Support in maintaining specific daily program data required for Achieve Miami and the Children's Trust.
- Manage site case notes, including creating and implementing behavior intervention plans tailored to individual student needs.
- Collaborate with families to reinforce positive behavior practices at home.
- Observe Enrichment classroom instruction to provide feedback and help them implement positive behavior support systems and classroom management strategies.
- Provide additional support to students with disabilities, IEPs, or behavior plans, helping them develop social-emotional and self-regulation skills.
- Contribute to school-wide initiatives to foster a positive culture.
- Participate in staff retreats before summer begins to adequately prepare and be ready for the program (see below for schedule).

Who we are Looking For

To excel as a Reading & Behavior Interventionist, a candidate should possess the following qualities:

- **Data-driven decision-making:** You use data to inform your decisions and improve outcomes. You accurately track, analyze, and interpret information to guide program planning and monitor student progress.
- **Organizational skills:** You thrive on planning and staying organized. You stay on top of your to-do list, can integrate new priorities and manage your workload effectively.
- **Communication skills:** You provide clear, proactive, and respectful information to participants, staff, and stakeholders. You have the ability to communicate feedback clearly and respectfully.
- **Proactive problem-solving and adaptability:** You take initiative to anticipate challenges, develop solutions, and guide others in adjusting quickly, thriving in dynamic and high-pressure environments.
- **Continuous improvement:** You are committed to growth, actively seeking and applying feedback from staff, parents, and participants to enhance the program.
- **Cultural competence:** You have sensitivity and understanding of various cultures, backgrounds, and identities, ensuring an inclusive and respectful environment for everyone involved.

Additional Qualifications

- A certified teacher with experience in reading instruction
- Experience implementing Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS)
- An understanding of how to build a strong culture of learning, growth, and joy
- Experience using Google Workspace tools—especially Google Docs, Google Drive, and Google Meet (preferred)
- Current staff member at one of the Achieve Summer school sites (preferred)
